Our unique family governance model ensures housemates and their families are the key decision-makers, while we take care of the day-to-day admin and logistics, maintaining a high degree of transparency and trust.

KEY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rent is 25% of your income plus Commonwealth Rent Assistance.
- Bills are split evenly between three housemates and Fighting Chance (i.e. you will pay 25% of each bill). Fighting Chance will pay these expenses upfront and you will be invoiced monthly for your share.
- Groceries can be shared between housemates, or you can manage your own groceries separately - or you can do a combination of both!
- 24-hour in-house support is covered by your Supported Independent Living (SIL) NDIS funding. We are looking for someone to move in as soon as possible so you will ideally already have a Housing Functional Capacity Assessment completed by an occupational therapist, or funding in your current NDIS plan to get this completed. Fighting Chance can work with you to apply for SIL funding.
