KEY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rent is 25% of your income plus Commonwealth Rent Assistance.
- Bills are split evenly between three housemates and Fighting Chance (i.e. you will pay 25% of each bill). Fighting Chance will pay these expenses upfront and you will be invoiced monthly for your share.
- Groceries can be shared between housemates, or you can manage your own groceries separately - or you can do a combination of both!
- 24-hour in-house support is covered by your Supported Independent Living (SIL) NDIS funding. We are looking for a roommate as soon as possible. If you have not already, you will need to have a Housing Functional Capacity Assessment completed by an occupational therapist, or funding in your current NDIS plan to get this completed. Fighting Chance can work with you to apply for SIL funding.
